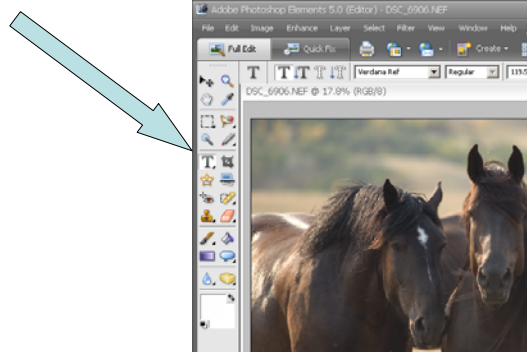


## Creating watermarks for your Images using Adobe Photoshop Elements 5.0

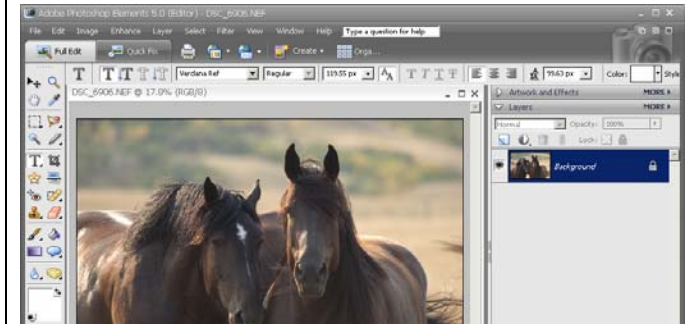
### Watermarks

- Used to stamp ownership on your images
- Provide some protection
- Makes it harder for people to steal your images
- Very easy to do.

1. Once you have completed your image...
2. Click the Text tool found on the tool bar



3. Click anywhere to begin creating your watermark.
4. Note: to create the © symbol, use your ALT key and the number pad. Hold "ALT" while typing 0169, then let go of the "Alt" button.
5. Enter the remaining text for your watermark.

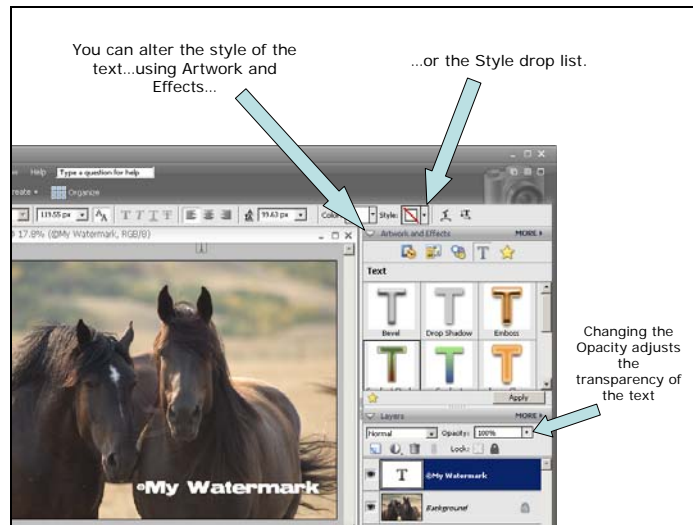
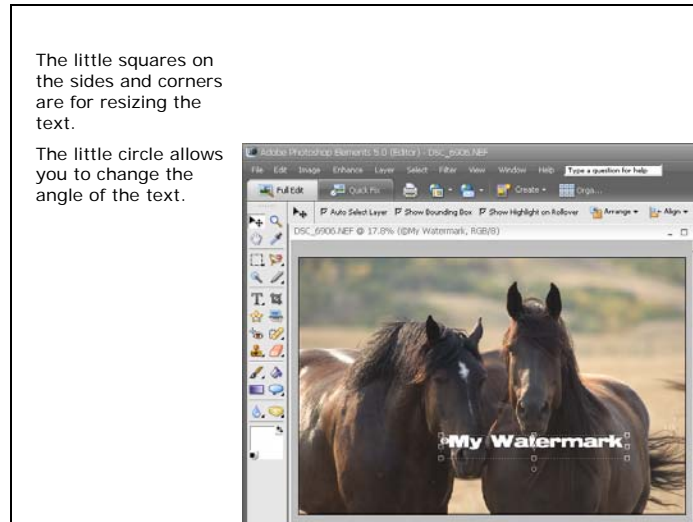
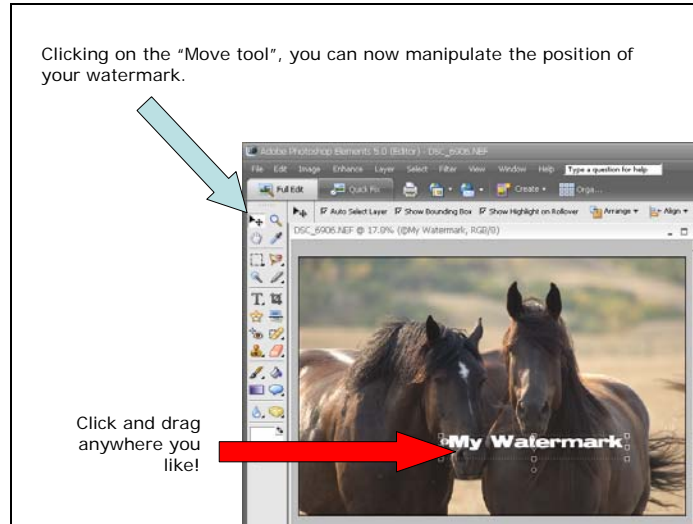


Notice that a new Layer was automatically created.  
This means that the image itself is not changed at all.



By highlighting the text, you can now change the font type, style, justification, colour with the Font toolbar.





Now you simply save your image...and it is ready for the gallery.

Click FILE, then Save As...
